EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE

OF 29 APRIL 2025

ON THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE APPLICATION OF
ARTICLE 2 (3) OF COLLEGE DECISION 023/2025 OF 26
FEBRUARY 2025

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017 /1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (the EPPO),¹ hereinafter referred to as "the EPPO Regulation", and in particular Articles 17 and 114(c) thereof

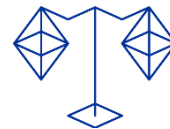
Having regard to Regulation No 31 (EEC), 11 (EAEC), laying down the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Economic Community and the European Community of Atomic Energy, hereinafter referred to as "the Staff Regulations" and, respectively "the CEOS", and in particular to Articles 90 and 91 of the Staff Regulations and Article 124 of the CEOS²,

Having regard to the Decision 015/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 12 February 2025 on the Conditions of employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and replacing and repealing Decisions 001/2020, 013/2020, 017/2021, 013/2021, 098/2021, 007/2023 and 058/2024 of the College of the EPPO, hereinafter referred to as "the COEEDP", and in particular Article 15 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 023/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 26 February 2025 on the performance criteria and the procedure for appraisal of the European Delegated

Prosecutors, and replacing and repealing college decision 030/2021, and in particular Article 2 (3) thereof,

Considering the need to establish technical criteria for the implementation of that provision, in particular for what concerns the application of the level of professional performance of European Delegated Prosecutors designated as “highly satisfactory”, which has been newly introduced by Decision 023/2025,

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

The application of Article 2 (3) of Decision 023/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 26 February 2025 on the performance criteria and the procedure for appraisal of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and replacing and repealing College decision 030/2021 is suspended in the part where it provides for the possibility to determine the level of professional performance as “highly satisfactory”. The remaining parts of Article 2 (3) shall continue to apply.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption, and shall remain into force until the adoption by the College of the EPPO of a decision establishing guidelines on the determination of the level of professional performance as “highly satisfactory”.
