

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE
EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE
OF 23 SEPTEMBER 2026

APPOINTING A MEMBER OF THE DISCIPLINARY BOARD
FOR EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTORS

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ("the EPPO"),

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ("the EPPO")¹, and in particular Articles 9, 13 and 17 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision 003/2020 of the College of the EPPO of 12 October 2020 on the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO, as subsequently amended and supplemented by the Decisions 085/2021, 026/2022, and 010/2024 of the College of the EPPO, and in particular Articles 7 and 8 thereof,

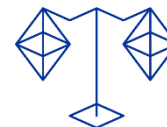
Having regard to the Decision 044/2021 of the College of EPPO of 12 May 2021 laying down rules on the disciplinary liability of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and in particular Articles 9 and 10,

Having regard to the Decision 015/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 12 February 2025 on the Conditions of employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and replacing and repealing Decisions 001/2020, 013/2020, 017/2021, 013/2021, 098/2021, 007/2023, 058/2024 and 026/2026 of the College of the EPPO, hereinafter referred to as "the COEEDP", and in particular Article 34 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision 029/2024 of the College of the EPPO of 29 May 2024 and the Decision 012/2026 of 11 March 2026 appointing members of the disciplinary board for European Delegated Prosecutors,

Considering the candidacies submitted and the result of the secret vote held at its meeting of 23 September 2026,

Whereas:

- (1) The Disciplinary Board for European Delegated Prosecutors shall consist of five (5) European Prosecutors appointed by the College for a period of three (3) years.
- (2) The term of office of Mr Juraj NOVOCKÝ ended on 28 July 2026 and there is the need to nominate a European Prosecutor as new member of the Disciplinary Board for the European Delegated Prosecutors.

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

Composition of the Disciplinary Board

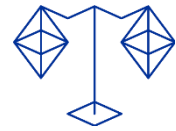
1. Mr Omar CARUANA, European Prosecutor, is hereby appointed as member of the Disciplinary Board for European Delegated Prosecutors for a period of three years starting from the date of the entry into force of this decision, without prejudice to the duration of their term of office as European Prosecutor.
2. Without prejudice to the length of the appointment of the other members and alternate members of the Board set out in Article 1 of the College Decision 029/2024 and in Article 1 of the College Decision 012/2026, as from the date of entry into force of this decision, the composition of the Disciplinary Board is the following:
