

# DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 28 JANUARY 2026

## ON THE ADOPTION BY ANALOGY OF COMMISSION DECISION C(2025)2495 OF 13 MAY 2025 ON THE GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING ARTICLES 11, 12 AND 13 OF ANNEX VII TO THE STAFF REGULATIONS OF OFFICIALS AND ON AUTHORISED TRAVEL

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017 /1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'),<sup>1</sup> hereinafter referred to as 'EPPO Regulation', and in particular Article 96(4) thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union ('CEOS')<sup>2</sup>, and in particular to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations;

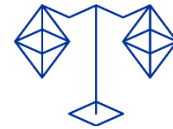
Having regard to the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO,<sup>3</sup> and in particular Articles 7, 8 and 12, Having regard to Communication C(2014)6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies, and in particular Point 3.1 thereof,

Having regard to Commission Decision C(2025)2495 of 13 May 2025 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11, 12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials and on authorised travel (hereinafter referred to as "Commission Decision C(2025)2495"),

After consulting the Staff Committee,

Whereas:

- (1) Pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations implementing rules adopted by the Commission to give effect to the Staff Regulations shall apply by analogy to the agencies and to that end, the Commission informs the agencies of any such implementing rule without delay after adoption.
- (2) On 14 May 2025 the Commission informed the agencies on the adoption of Commission Decision C(2025)2495 of 13 May 2025 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11, 12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials and on authorised travel.
- (3) This communication triggered the nine-month deadline for agencies to decide if they will apply the rules by analogy or request a derogation.
- (4) Pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations, such implementing rules enter into force at the agencies nine months after their entry into force at the Commission or nine months after the date on which the Commission informed the agencies of the adoption of the respective implementing rule, whichever is later. Notwithstanding the foregoing, an agency may also decide that such implementing rules are to enter into force at an earlier date.
- (5) The dedicated IT tool for managing missions is configured based on the applicability of Commission Decision C(2025)2495 as of 13 May 2025.

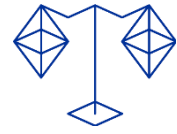
Has adopted this Decision:

## Article 1

The Commission Decision C(2025)2495 of 13 May 2025 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11, 12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of Officials and on authorised travel, as annexed to this Decision, shall apply by analogy to the EPPO.

## Article 2

1. This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
2. In the interest of clarity and legal certainty, Commission Decision C(2017) 5323 on the general provisions for implementing Articles 11, 12 and 13 of Annex VII to the Staff Regulations of



Officials (mission expenses) and on authorised travel<sup>4</sup> shall no longer apply by analogy to the EPPO.

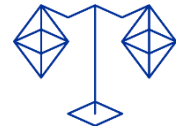
