



DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 9 JUNE 2021

APPOINTING FIVE EUROPEAN PROSECUTORS AS MEMBERS OF THE DISCIPLINARY BOARD FOR THE EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTORS

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'), and in particular Articles 9, 13 and 17 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 003/2020 of 12 October 2020 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office on the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO, and in particular Article 8 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 044/2021 of 12 May 2021 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office laying down rules on the disciplinary liability of the European Delegated Prosecutors,

Having regard to the candidacies submitted and the result of the secret vote held at its extraordinary meeting of 9 June 2021,

Has adopted the following Decision:

Article 1
