EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE
OF 15 October 2025

ON THE EXTENSION OF A DESIGNATION OF A EUROPEAN
DELEGATED PROSECUTOR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 16(7) OF
THE EPPO REGULATION AND THE ASSIGNMENT OF
ADDITIONAL TASKS

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017 /1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ("the EPPO"), hereinafter referred to as "the EPPO Regulation",¹ and in particular Articles 13(2), 16(7), 17 and 96 thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of employment of Other Servants ('CEOS') of the European Union,² and in particular to Article 123 of the CEOS,

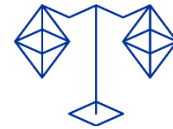
Having regard to the Decision 003/2020 of the College of the EPPO of 12 October 2020 on the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO (hereinafter referred to as "the Internal Rules of Procedure"), as subsequently amended and supplemented,³ and in particular Articles 31 and 34 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision 015/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 12 February 2025 on the Conditions of employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and replacing and repealing Decisions 001/2020, 013/2020, 017/2021, 013/2021, 098/2021, 007.2023 and 058/2024 of the College of the EPPO (hereinafter referred to as the "CEEDP"), and in particular Articles 20 and 21 thereof,

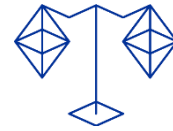
Having regard to the Decision 002/2021 of the College of the EPPO of 13 January 2021 on the Financial Rules applicable to the EPPO, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Financial Rules"),⁴ and in particular Article 78 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision 069/2023 of the College of the EPPO of 20 October 2023 designating a European Delegated Prosecutor pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation (hereafter referred to as "College Decision 069/2023"),

Whereas:

1. Pursuant to College Decision 069/2023, the College of the EPPO has approved the designation of Ms. Jolita KANCAUSKIENE, European Delegated Prosecutor, to substitute the Lithuanian European Prosecutor in case he is unable to carry out his functions or leaves his position.
2. This substitution will expire on 20 October 2025.
3. By a reasoned proposal dated 9 October 2025, Mr. Gedgaudas NORKUNAS, European Prosecutor, proposed to the College:
 - a) To extend the designation of Ms. Jolita KANCAUSKIENE, European Delegated Prosecutor in the Republic of Lithuania, to substitute for a period of 2 years the Lithuanian European Prosecutor in case he is unable to carry out his functions or leave his position pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation, from 21 October 2025 until 20 October 2027.
 - b) Pursuant to Article 20 of the CEDEDP, to approve for the above-mentioned period the assignment to Ms. Jolita KANCAUSKIENE of additional tasks, and in particular:
 - I. The responsibility to represent the EPPO in Lithuania for institutional, administrative, and other matters, in cooperation with the competent national authorities and in consultation with Mr. Gedgaudas NORKUNAS, European Prosecutor.
 - II. The coordination of the other staff put at the disposal of the EPPO in Lithuania pursuant to Article 98(1) of the EPPO Regulation, as well as relations with the media and communication.
 - III. The coordination of the activities of the Lithuanian European Delegated Prosecutors, particularly in the field of mutual legal assistance.

Has adopted this Decision:

Article 1

Extension of the designation pursuant to Article 16(7) EPPO Regulation

The College hereby approves the extension for a period of 2 years, from 21 October 2025 until 20 October 2027, of the designation of Ms. Jolita KANCAUSKIENE, European Delegated Prosecutor in the Republic of Lithuania, to substitute the Lithuanian European Prosecutor in case he is unable to carry out his functions or leaves his position pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation.

Article 2

Additional Tasks

The College approves the assignment, for the period mentioned in Article 1, of additional tasks to Ms. Jolita KANCAUSKIENE, European Delegated Prosecutor in the Republic of Lithuania, as proposed in his reasoned proposal, and in particular:

- a) The responsibility to represent the EPPO in Lithuania for institutional, administrative, and other matters, in cooperation with the competent national authorities and in consultation with Mr. Gedgaudas NORKUNAS, European Prosecutor.
- b) The coordination of the other staff put at the disposal of the EPPO in Lithuania pursuant to Article 98(1) of the EPPO Regulation, as well as relations with the media and communication.
- c) the coordination of the activities of the Lithuanian European Delegated Prosecutors, particularly in the field of mutual legal assistance.

Article 3

Entry into force

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
