

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 29 JUNE 2022

ON DELIVERING THE COLLEGE OPINION IN RESPECT OF EPPO's 2021 FINAL ACCOUNTS

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 1939/2017 of 12 October 2017¹, implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'), hereinafter "the constituent act", and in particular Article 94 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 002/2021 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office on the Financial Rules applicable to the EPPO, hereinafter referred to as "EPPO's Financial Rules", and in particular Article 103 thereof,

Whereas:

In accordance with Article 103(3) of the Decision 002/2021 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office on EPPO's Financial Rules, the College shall give an opinion on EPPO's final accounts as drawn up by EPPO's Accounting Officer and submitted to the College by the Administrative Director.

Has adopted the following Decision:

Article 1

Subject to any observations published by the European Court of Auditors in its report on the final accounts of EPPO for the financial year 2021, the College having received the aforementioned final accounts expresses a favourable opinion on these accounts.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.
