



DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 29 JUNE 2022

ON DELIVERING THE COLLEGE OPINION IN RESPECT OF EPPO'S 2021 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL ACTIVITY REPORT (CAAR)

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017¹, implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'), and in particular Article 94 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 002/2021 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office on the Financial Rules applicable to the EPPO, hereinafter referred to as "EPPO's Financial Rules", and in particular Article 48 thereof,

Whereas:

In accordance with Article 48(1) last sentence of the EPPO's Financial Rules, the Consolidated Annual Activity Report shall be submitted to the College for the assessment.

Has adopted the following Decision:

Article 1

The College, having assessed the 2021 Consolidated Annual Activity Report, gives a positive opinion, as elaborated on page 5 of the Report.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.
