

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 20 JULY 2022

Appointing the Accounting Officer of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO')

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 1939/2017 of 12 October 2017¹, implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'), and in particular Articles 94 and 95 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 002/2021 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office on the Financial Rules applicable to the EPPO, hereinafter referred to as "EPPO's Financial Rules", and in particular Article 50 thereof,

Whereas:

In accordance with Article 50(1) of EPPO's Financial Rules, the EPPO College shall appoint an accounting officer, covered by the Staff Regulations² and chosen on the grounds of his or her particular competence as evidenced by diplomas or by equivalent professional experience, who shall be totally independent in the performance of his or her duties, and be responsible for the tasks set out in that article,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Ms. Adrienn Karko is hereby appointed as the Accounting Officer of the European Public Prosecutor's Office.
