

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 12 JANUARY 2023

ON THE RESIGNATION OF MR. BOYKO KIRILOV KALFIN FROM HIS POSITION AS EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTOR

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'), and in particular Articles 9, 13 and 17 thereof,

Noting that on 6 January 2023 Mr. Boyko Kirilov Kalfin, European Delegated Prosecutor from the Republic of Bulgaria, appointed by this College on 7 April 2021 with Decision n° 022/2021, has communicated to the European Chief Prosecutor and the Administrative Director his intention to resign from his position,

Having considered the proposal of the European Chief Prosecutor to take note of the resignation and waive the notice period provided for by Article 24 (1) of the Conditions of Employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors (CEEDP) in consideration of the fact that Mr Kalfin is due to take up another judicial office on 16 January 2023,

HAS DECIDED HAS FOLLOWS:

- 1. To take note of the decision to resign of Mr. Boyko Kirilov Kalfin, European Delegated Prosecutor from the Republic of Bulgaria,
- 2. To approve waiving partially the notice period provided by Article 24 (1) CEEDP following the resignation, giving effect to his resignation from 16 January 2023.
