

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 26 APRIL 2023

DESIGNATING A EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTOR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 16(7) OF THE EPPO REGULATION

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017 /1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ("EPPO") (hereinafter referred to as "the EPPO Regulation"), and in particular Articles 13(2), 16(7), 17 and 96 thereof,

Having regard to Regulation No 31 (EEC), 11 (EAEC), laying down the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Economic Community and the European Community of Atomic Energy, hereinafter referred to as "the Staff Regulations" and, respectively "the CEOS", and in particular to Articles 123 of the CEOS,

Having regard to Decision of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office of 29 September 2020 laying down rules on condition of employment of the European Delegated Prosecutor, as subsequently amended and supplemented (hereinafter referred to as "the CEEDP"), and in particular Article 14-16 thereof,

Having regard to Decision of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office of 12 October 2020 on the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO (hereinafter referred to as "the Internal Rules of Procedure"), as subsequently amended and supplemented, and in particular Articles 31 and 34 thereof.

Having regard to Decision of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office of 13 January 2021 on the Financial Rules applicable to the EPPO (hereinafter "the Financial Rules"), and in particular Article 78 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office of 24 February 2021 laying down rules on the rights of the European Delegated Prosecutors designated to substitute the European Prosecutor of their Member State (hereinafter "the College Decision 013/2021"),

Considering that Ms. Maria MALLOUCHOU, designated to substitute the Greek European Prosecutor by Decision 60/2021 of the College of the EPPO, will retire from the national judicial service on 30 June 2023, while the mandate of Mr Dimitrios ZIMIANITIS as European Prosecutor will end on 29 July 2023,



Considering the need to ensure the swift functioning of the EPPO both at central level (in view of the forthcoming appointment of a new European Prosecutor for Greece and the possible need that the departing one is substituted at certain instances according to the EPPO Regulation) as well as at decentralised level,

Having regard to the reasoned proposal of Mr Dimitrios ZIMIANITIS, European Prosecutor, dated 24 April 2023, proposing to the College:

- to approve the designation of Ms. Evgenia KYVELOU, European Delegated Prosecutor, to substitute him in case he is unable to carry out his functions or left his position pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation and
- to approve the assignment of additional tasks to Ms. Evgenia KYVELOU, European Delegated Prosecutor, as proposed in the above-mentioned reasoned proposal, pursuant to Article 3(2) of the College Decision 013/2021.

Has adopted the following decision:

Article 1

Designation pursuant to Article 16(7) EPPO Regulation

The College approves the designation of Ms. Evgenia KYVELOU, European Delegated Prosecutor, to substitute the Greek European Prosecutor in case he is unable to carry out his functions or leaves his position pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation.

Article 2

Additional Tasks

The College approves the assignment of additional tasks to Ms. Evgenia KYVELOU, European Delegated Prosecutor, as foreseen in the reasoned proposal of the Greek European Prosecutor, pursuant to Article 3(2) of the College Decision 013/2021.

Article 3

Repeal

On the date of the entry into force of this decision, Decision 60/2021 of the College of the EPPO of 19 May 2021 is repealed.

Article 4

Entry into force

This decision shall enter into force on 1 June 2023.
