

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 28 JUNE 2023

APPOINTING MR PETR KLEMENT AS DEPUTY EUROPEAN CHIEF PROSECUTOR

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'), and in particular Articles 9, 11 and 15 thereof,

Having regard to the Council Implementing Decision (EU) 2020/1117 of 27 July 2020 appointing the European Prosecutors of the European Public Prosecutor's Office, and in particular Article 2 thereof,

Having regard to the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO, adopted by the College on 12 October 2020, and in particular Articles 26-29 thereof,

Considering that the mandate as European Prosecutor of Mr Danilo Ceccarelli will end on 28 July 2023, and that therefore he will cease on the same date in his functions as Deputy European Chief Prosecutor in accordance with Article 15 of Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939,

On the basis of the proposal made by the European Chief Prosecutor pursuant to Article 26 of the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO,

Taking into account the application, accompanied by a statement of motivation and the presentation by the candidate at its meeting of 28 June 2023,

Having regard the result of the secret vote held at that meeting,

Has adopted the following Decision:

Article 1

Mr Petr KLEMENT is appointed Deputy European Chief Prosecutor for a mandate period of 3 years, which shall not exceed the period for his mandate as European Prosecutor, with effect from 29 July 2023.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
