

## DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 20 OCTOBER 2023

## ON THE SUBSTITUTION OF THE EUROPEAN PROSECUTOR FROM THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 16 (7) EPPO REGULATION

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO') ("the EPPO Regulation"), and in particular Articles 12, 13 and 16 (7) thereof,

Having regard to the Council Implementing Decision (EU) 2020/1117 of 27 July 2020 appointing the European Prosecutors of the European Public Prosecutor's Office, and in particular Article 2 thereof,

Having regard to the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO, adopted by the College on 12 October 2020, and in particular Article 31 thereof,

Having regard to College Decision 051/2023 of 10 July 2023, with which Mr Paul Notenboom has been designated to substitute the European Prosecutor from the Kingdom of the Netherlands in all duties provided for by the EPPO Regulation, in particular by Articles 9, 10 and 12, with effect from 29 July 2023 and until 28 October 2023,

Considering that the appointment of the new European Prosecutor from the Kingdom of the Netherlands, Ms Miranda De Meijer, will take effect on 1 November 2023,

Considering the need to ensure continuity until that date of the substitution of the European Prosecutor from the Netherlands, with regard to the need to ensure seamless continuity in the functions as member of the College, member of the Permanent Chambers and supervising European Prosecutor in respect of the ongoing investigations,

On the basis of the proposal made by the European Chief Prosecutor pursuant to Article 31 of the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO,

Has adopted the following Decision:



## Article 1

The designation of Mr Paul Notenboom to substitute the European Prosecutor from the Kingdom of the Netherlands in all duties provided for by the EPPO Regulation, in particular by Articles 9, 10 and 12, is prolonged until 31 October 2023.

## Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
