

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 15 APRIL 2024

DESIGNATING A EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTOR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 16(7) OF THE EPPO REGULATION

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ("EPPO") (hereinafter referred to as "the EPPO Regulation")¹, and in particular Articles 13(2), 16(7), 17 and 96 thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Communities (hereinafter "Staff Regulations"), and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities (hereinafter "CEOS")², and in particular to Articles 5, 123 and 124 of the CEOS,

Having regard to Decision 001/2020 of the College of the EPPO of 29 September 2020 laying down rules on conditions of employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors, as amended by Decisions 017/2021, 103/2021 and 007/2023 of the College of the EPPOCondition of Employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors, (hereinafter referred to as "the CEEDP"), and in particular Articles 14-16 thereof,

Having regard to the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO (hereinafter referred to as "the Internal Rules of Procedure")³, and in particular Articles 31 and 34 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 002/2021 of the College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office of 13 January 2021 on the Financial Rules applicable to the EPPO (hereinafter "the Financial Rules"), as amended by the Decision 023/2023 of the College of the EPPO of 19 April 2023, and in particular Article 78 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision 013/2021 of the College of the EPPO of 24 February 2021 laying down rules on the rights of the European Delegated Prosecutors designated to substitute the European Prosecutor of their Member State (hereinafter "the College Decision 013/2021"),

Having regard to the reasoned proposal of Ms. Miranda de Meijer, European Prosecutor, dated 10 April 2024, proposing to the College:

- to approve the designation from 15 April 2024 until 14 April 2025 of Mr. Paulus Notenboom, European Delegated Prosecutor, to substitute her in case she is unable to carry out her functions or left her position pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation, and
- to approve the assignment of additional tasks from 15 April 2024 until 14 April 2025 to Mr. Paulus Notenboom, European Delegated Prosecutor, as proposed in the abovementioned reasoned proposal, pursuant to Article 3(2) of the College Decision 013/2021.

Has adopted the following rules:

Article 1

Designation pursuant to Article 16(7) EPPO Regulation

The College approves the designation for a duration of one year, with effect from 15 April 2024, of Mr. Paulus Notenboom, European Delegated Prosecutor, to substitute the Dutch European Prosecutor in case she is unable to carry out her functions or left her position pursuant to Article 16(7) of the EPPO Regulation.

Article 2

Additional Tasks

The College approves the assignment of additional tasks for a duration of one year, with effect from 15 April 2024, to Mr. Paulus Notenboom, European Delegated Prosecutor, as proposed in the above-mentioned reasoned proposal, pursuant to Article 3(2) of the College Decision 013/2021.

Article 3

Entry into force

This decision shall enter into force on 15 April 2024.
