

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE
EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE
OF 26 FEBRUARY 2025

ON THE EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY OCCUPATION OF
THE MANAGEMENT POST OF ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR OF
THE EPPO

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union ('Staff Regulations') and to the Conditions of employment of other servants of the European Union ('CEOS'),¹ and in particular Article 7(2) of the Staff Regulations and Article 10 of the CEOS,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (hereinafter referred to as the "EPPO Regulation"),² and in particular Article 96 thereof,

Having regard to the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO,³ and in particular Article 8 thereof,

Having regard to the Decision of the College of the EPPO 089/2021 of 8 September 2021 on implementing rules on temporary occupation of management posts (hereinafter referred to as the "College Decision 089/2021"),

Having regard to the Decision 025/2024 of the College of the EPPO of 24 April 2024 for the temporary occupation of the management post of Administrative Director of the EPPO,

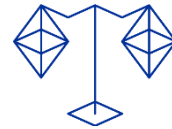
Having regard to the Decision 047/2024 of the College of the EPPO of 4 September 2024 granting the acting Administrative Director of the EPPO a differential allowance,

Having regard to the Decision 006/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 29 January 2025 on the retirement of Mr Olivier RAMSAYER, Administrative Director of the EPPO,

Having regard to the reasoned proposal from the Head of the Human Resources Unit to the College of the EPPO for a temporary posting in accordance with article 7(2) Staff Regulations of 21 February 2025,

Whereas:

1. According to Decision 025/2024 of the College of the EPPO of 28 April 2024, Ms. Kristel SIITAM-NYIRI has been assigned to temporarily occupy the position of acting Administrative Director of the EPPO as of 29 April 2024, until Mr. Olivier RAMSAYER, who has been in prolonged and justified absence, would have returned to service.
2. The circumstances of this temporary assignment were reassessed and confirmed by the College of the EPPO at its meeting on 12 June 2024.
3. According to the Decision 006/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 29 January 2025, the employment of Mr RAMSAYER with the EPPO will cease on 28 February 2025, due to his retirement.
4. There is the need to ensure full business continuity in the exercise of the functions of the Administrative Director as defined by Article 19 of the EPPO Regulation until a new Administrative Director will have been appointed by the College of the EPPO and she/he will have taken up her/his duties.
5. The conditions to extend up to the maximum duration of one year the temporary posting of Ms Kristel SIITAM-NYIRI to the position of Administrative Director, in accordance with Article 7(2) Staff Regulation and the corresponding implementing rules of College Decision 089/2021, are met.

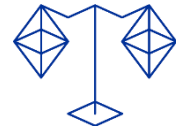
Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

1. Ms Kristel SIITAM-NYIRI shall continue to temporarily occupy the post of Acting Administrative Director of the EPPO until the College will appoint an Administrative Director and she/he will take up her/his duties, but in any case until not later than 28 April 2025.
2. Ms. Kristel SIITAM-NYIRI shall continue to receive the differential allowance in accordance with the provisions set out in Article 4 of the College Decision 089/2021 for the duration of her temporary posting.

Article 2

This Decision shall take effect on 1 March 2025.
