

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE
EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE
OF 4 JUNE 2025
ON THE DISMISSAL ON GROUNDS OF RESIGNATION OF A
EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTOR
IN THE REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO') (hereinafter referred to as 'the EPPO Regulation'),¹ and in particular Article 17 thereof,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants ('CEOS') of the European Union,²

Having regard to the Conditions of Employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors (hereinafter referred to as "CEEDP"),³ and in particular Articles 11 and 12 thereof,

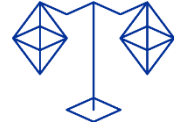
Whereas:

- (1) The contract of Employment of a European Delegated Prosecutor shall be terminated by the EPPO in the cases provided for by Article 12 CEEDP.
- (2) Ms. Silvia KRUUSMAA, European Delegated Prosecutor in the Republic of Estonia, informed the EPPO on 26 May 2025 of her intention to resign from her post starting on 27.8.2025.
- (3) Considering the proposal made by the European Chief Prosecutor dated 4 June 2025, and the documents accompanying the dismissal.

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

Ms. Silvia KRUUSMAA is hereby dismissed as European Delegated Prosecutor of the EPPO in the Republic of Estonia as of 27.8. 2025.

Article 2

The contract of employment as special adviser with the EPPO concluded with the person mentioned in Article 1 shall be terminated on 27 August 2025, in accordance with Article 12 of the CEEDP, and his term of office as European Delegated Prosecutor of the EPPO is deemed to be concluded on the same date.

Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
