EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE
OF 11 MARCH 2026

APPOINTING A MEMBER OF THE DISCIPLINARY BOARD FOR
EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTORS

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017 /1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (the EPPO),¹ hereinafter referred to as "the EPPO Regulation", and in particular Articles 9, 13 and 17,

Having regard to the Decision 003/2020 of the College of the EPPO of 12 October 2020 on the Internal Rules of Procedure of the EPPO, as amended and supplemented by the Decisions 085/2021 and 026/2022 of the College of the EPPO, and in particular Articles 7 and 8,


Having regard to the Decision 044/2021 of the College of EPPO of 12 May 2021 laying down rules on the disciplinary liability of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and in particular Articles 9 and 10,

Having regard to the Decision 029/2024 of the College of the EPPO of 29 May 2024 Appointing members of the disciplinary board for European Delegated Prosecutors (hereinafter referred to as the "College Decision 029/2024"),

Having regard to the Decision 015/2025 of the College of the EPPO of 12 February 2025 on the Conditions of employment of the European Delegated Prosecutors, and replacing and repealing Decisions 001/2020, 013/2020, 017/2021, 013/2021, 098/2021, 007/2023 and 058/2024 of the College of the EPPO, hereinafter referred to as "the COEEDP", and in particular Article 34 thereof,

Having regard to the candidacies submitted and the result of the secret vote,

Whereas:

- (1) The disciplinary board for European Delegated Prosecutors shall consist of five (5) European Prosecutors appointed by the College for a period of three (3) years. In addition, the College shall appoint two (2) European Prosecutors as alternate members.
- (2) Mr Petr Klement, former European Prosecutor for the Czech Republic and member of the disciplinary board, has left the EPPO and there is the need to nominate a European Prosecutor as new member of the disciplinary board for the European Delegated Prosecutors.

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

Appointment of a member of the disciplinary board


1. Mr Martin BRESMAN is hereby appointed as a member of the Disciplinary Board for European Delegated Prosecutors for a period of three (3) years.
2. Without prejudice to the length of the appointment of the other members of the board set out in Article 1 of the College Decision 029/2024, as from the date of the entry into force of this Decision, the composition of the Disciplinary Board for European Delegated Prosecutors is the following:
