ON THE ADOPTION BY ANALOGY OF THE COMMISSION RULES
FIXING RATES FOR THE DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE AND
CEILINGS FOR HOTEL EXPENSES FOR MISSIONS OUTSIDE THE
EUROPEAN TERRITORY OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE
EUROPEAN UNION

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO');

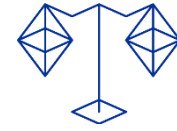
Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants ('CEOS') of the European Union,¹ and in particular to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations;

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),² hereinafter referred to as the "EPPO Regulation", and in particular Article 96(4) thereof;

Having regard to Communication C(2014)6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff

Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies, and in particular Point 3.1 thereof;

After consulting the Staff Committee,

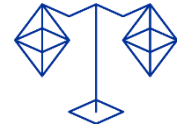
Whereas:

- 1) Pursuant to Article 96(4) of the EPPO Regulation, the College is competent to adopt the implementing rules of the Staff Regulations and the CEOS in accordance with Article 110 of the Staff Regulations.
- 2) On 6 March 2026 the European Commission formally notified the EPPO of the adoption of the Commission Decision C(2026)634 amending Decision C(2002) 98 fixing the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursements of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union, and further clarified that the Commission Decision C(2002) 98 of 16 January 2002 fixing the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursement of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union shall consequently be also adopted.
- 3) Pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations, implementing rules applicable to the Commission shall apply by analogy to the EPPO nine months after the date of notification from the Commission of 6 March 2026 or enter into force at an earlier date as per subparagraph 2 of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations.

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

1. The Commission Decision C(2002) 98 of 16 January 2002 fixing the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursement of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union, as annexed to this decision, shall apply by analogy to the EPPO.
2. The Commission Decision C(2026)634 amending Decision C(2002) 98 fixing the rates of the daily subsistence allowances and the ceilings for the reimbursements of hotel expenses for missions outside the European territory of the Member States of the European Union, as annexed to this decision, shall apply by analogy to the EPPO.



Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
