

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE  
EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE  
OF 17 JUNE 2026  
ON THE EPPO'S FINAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE  
FINANCIAL YEAR 2025

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 1939/2017 of 12 October 2017<sup>1</sup>, implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'), and in particular Article 94 thereof,

Having regard to Decision 002/2021 of the College of the EPPO on the Financial Rules applicable to the European Public Prosecutor's Office, as amended by Decision 023/2023 of the College of the EPPO of 19 April 2023 (hereinafter referred to as "EPPO's Financial Rules"), and in particular Article 103 thereof,

Considering the final accounts,

Whereas:

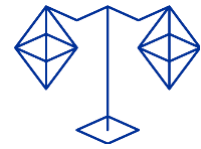
(1) Pursuant to Article 103(3) of the EPPO's Financial Rules:

- On receiving the observations of the European Court of Auditors on the provisional accounts of the EPPO, the Accounting Officer shall draw up the final accounts of the EPPO;
- The College shall give an opinion on EPPO's final accounts.

(2) Pursuant to Article 103(4) of the EPPO's Financial Rules, the Final accounts, together with the opinion of the College shall be sent to the Budgetary Authority, the Commission's Accounting Officer and the European Court of Auditors by 1 July 2026 at the latest.

Has adopted this decision:

#### Article 1
